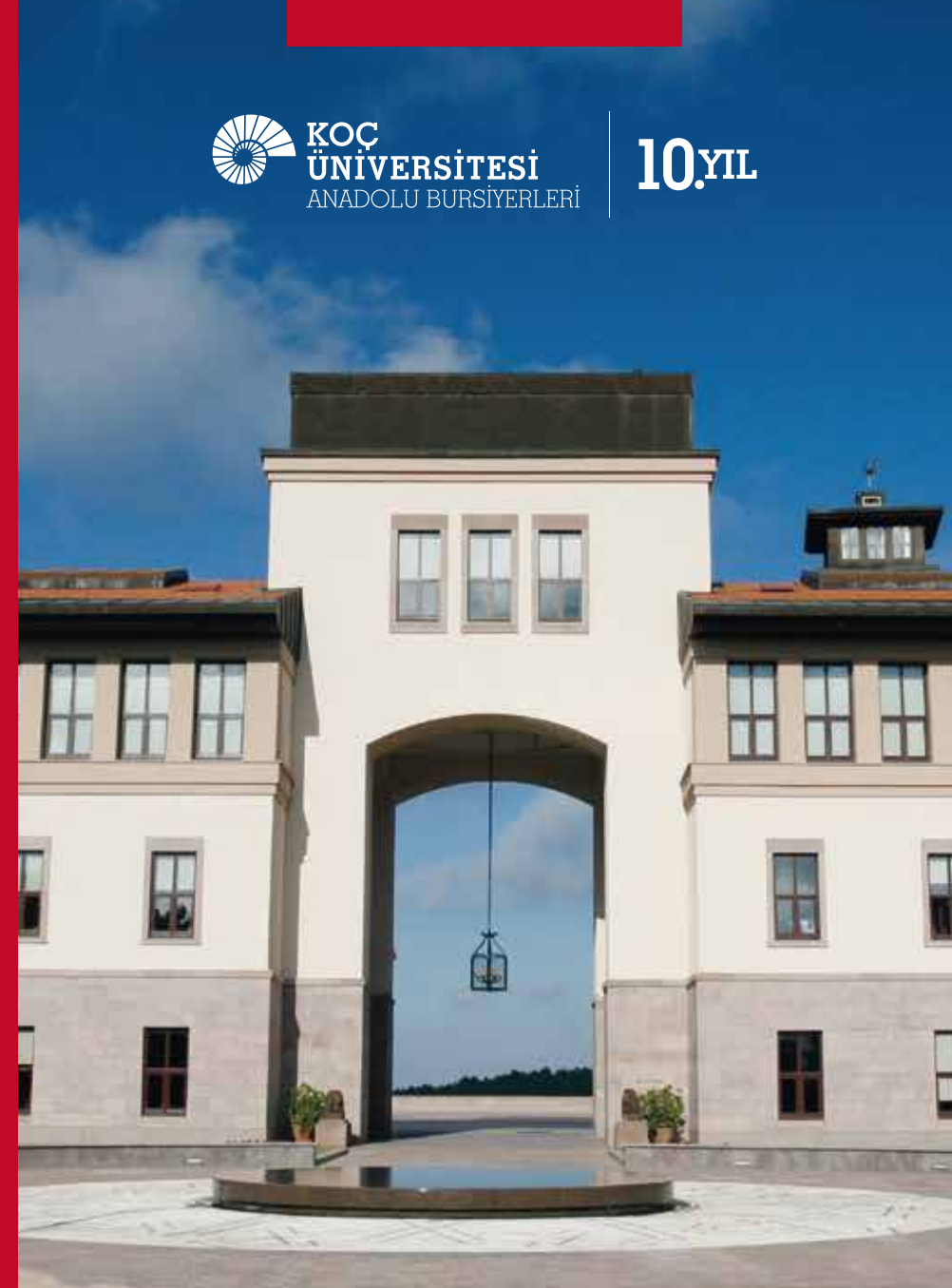

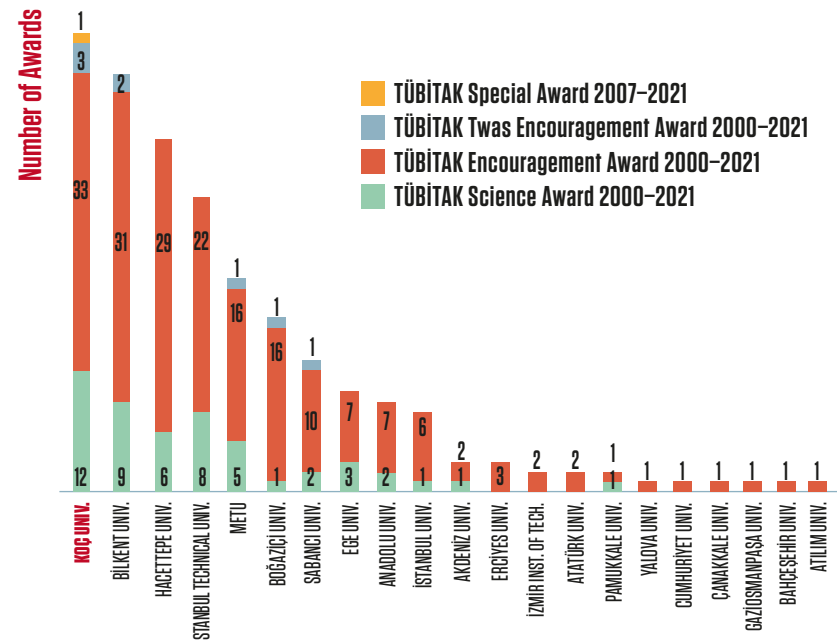

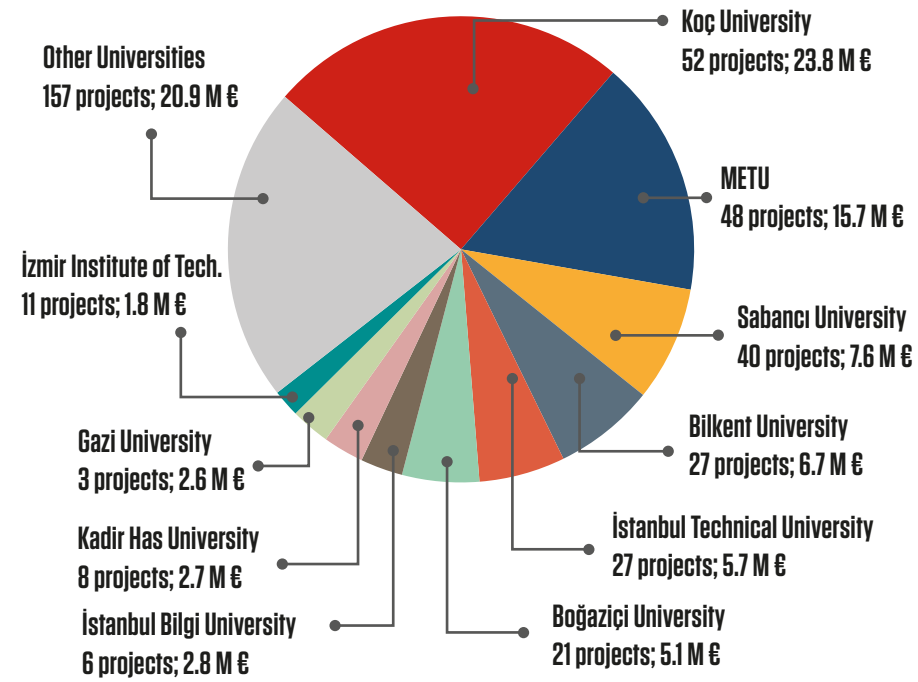

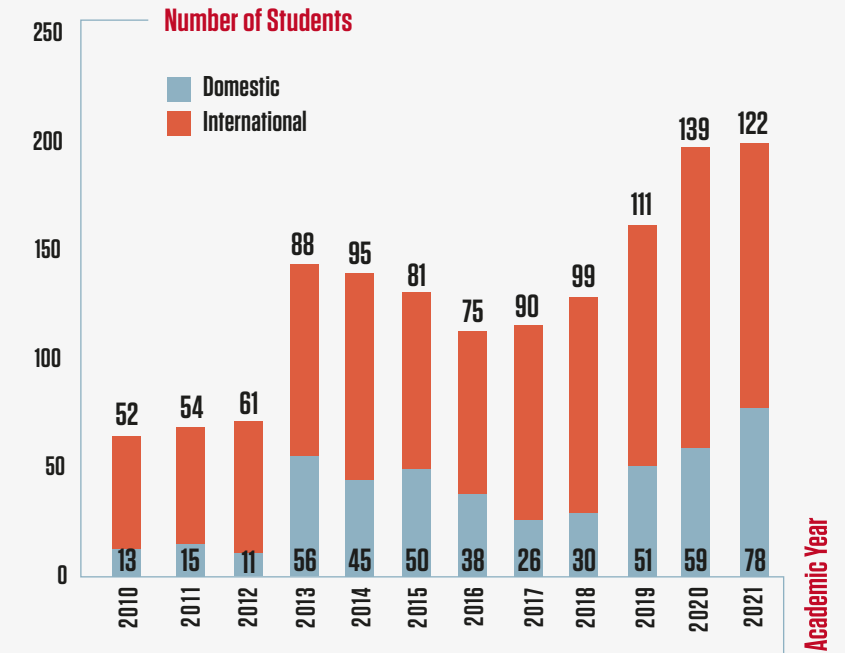

This chart is based on funding amounts.

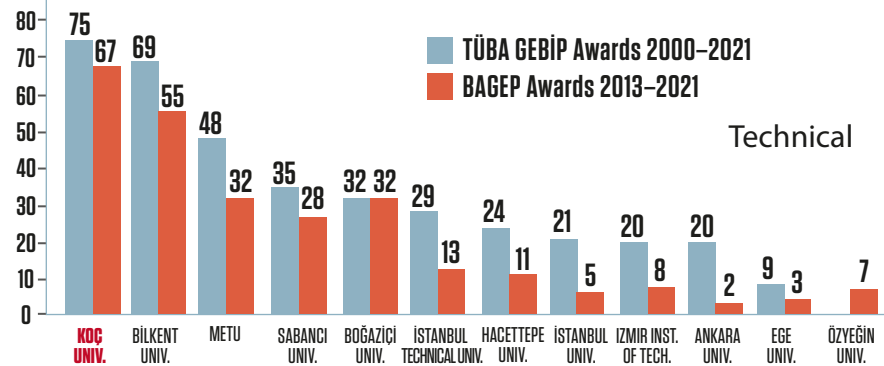


## KOÇ UNIVERSITY PHD STUDENT INTAKE

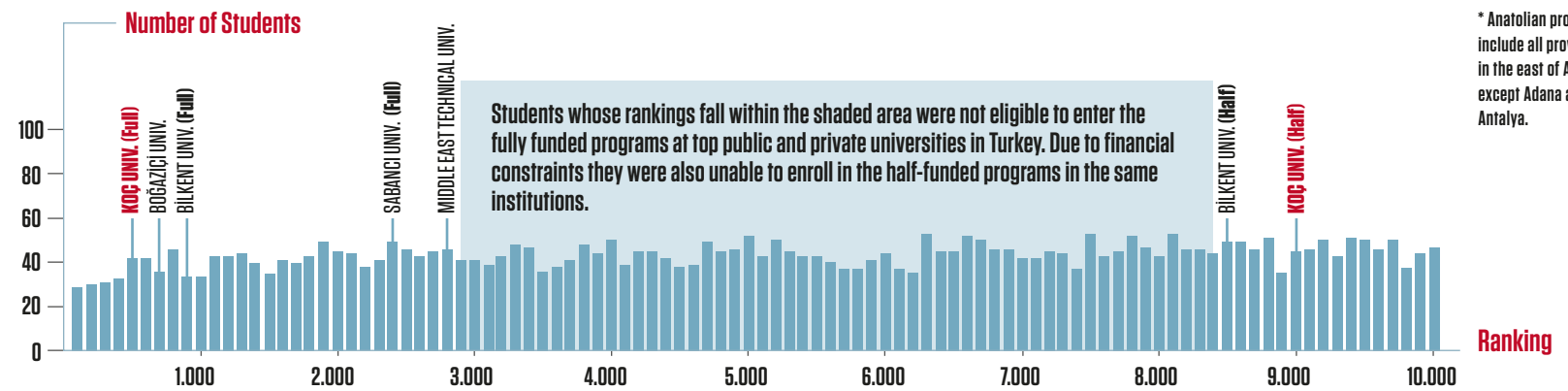

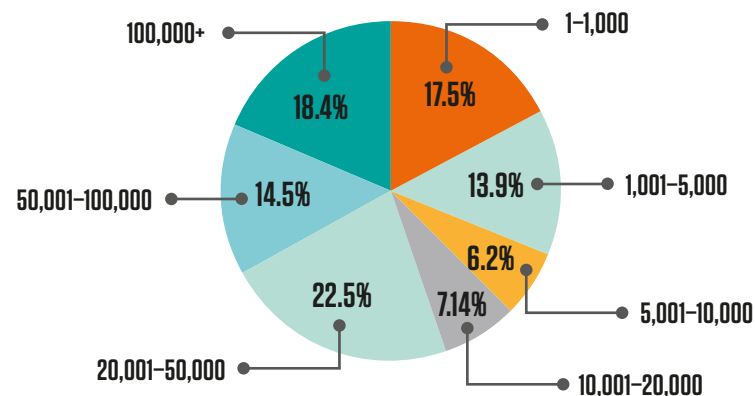
## REWARDING TOP TALENT (2010)

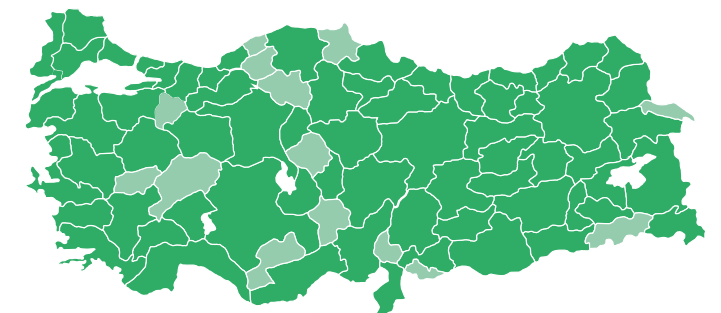

## THE ANATOLIAN SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM (2011–2021)

The Anatolian Scholarship Program is designed to provide wider access to high-quality education in Turkey. Leaving its 10<sup>th</sup> year behind, the Program, which started out with 6 donors and 14 students, has so far reached out to 982 bright students from all 81 provinces with the generous support of more than 300 corporate donors and 1,500 individuals.
